The Diocese of Norwich Children, Youth & Families Team support churches, schools and academies as they help young people grow in their Christian faith.

Resources

Shared resources can be a great way to access items that you only need for a short time or a specific project. At our Resource Centre based at Easton and our satellite sites at Loddon and Gaywood, we hold a catalogue of resources which schools, academies, churches and organisations can register to borrow for an annual fee of £25.

Whether you are wanting RE resources and Godly Play stories, open ended materials for creating reflective prayer activities and festival experiences, or games to put the fun into team building and fundraisers, we may have what you are looking for, including:

- RE artefacts boxes for Christianity, Judaism, Islam, Hinduism, Sikhism, Buddhism.
- Books on world religions, bereavement, Experience Christmas and Easter resource packs.
- Godly Play and reflective story sets that can be used as part of the RE Agreed Syllabus.
- Prayer Space resources including the big stuff like pop up gazebos, material drapes, and beanbags, to sensory items such as holding stones, plasma balls, finger labyrinths and fairy lights.
- Outdoor giant games and activities.
- Puppets, badge maker, instruments and much more.

Looking for a project that links your school with the local church?

We can provide advice and support around several recognised projects which can be run in and for schools, including:

Prayer Spaces in Schools – A space is creatively transformed to enable children and young people to explore life questions, spirituality, and faith in a safe, interactive, and multisensory way.

Godly Play – An imaginative storytelling approach using simple wooden sets to share sacred Bible stories, parables, and liturgical concepts, allowing for children to make their own personal responses.

Chaplaincy – We are working to help local churches better support schools by developing more formalised links through area chaplaincy teams. Get in touch if this is something that would interest you.

Open the Book – The major stories of the Bible delivered through short, scripted acts of collective worship led by a team of Christians from local churches.
